

HARVEST CHRISTIAN SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

CHAPEL DAY REQUIREMENTS

Girls required:

Navy, khaki, or plaid skirt, or navy, khaki, or plaid **“V-NECK”** jumper (when kneeling, length of skirt or jumper should be no more than three inches from floor to hem); white broadcloth or oxford blouse (short or long sleeve); dress shoes: tan, brown, black, navy, or tennis shoes. Socks: white, black, or brown. ***K4 thru 5th grade girls must wear navy or HCS plaid cross tie on Chapel days.***

Boys required:

Navy or khaki slacks **with belt** and white oxford shirt (short or long sleeve) with navy or HCS plaid tie; dress shoes: tan, brown, black, navy, or tennis shoes. Socks: white, black, or brown.

ITEMS FOR NON-CHAPEL DAYS

Navy or khaki slacks, walking shorts **with belt**, skorts (with front pleats). **Shorts & skirt/skort length:** When kneeling, length should be no more than three inches from floor to hem. White, light yellow, or light blue polo shirts, without trim or logos (short or long sleeve); navy or white sweaters, navy vest, matching ties, or bows. Coat or jacket colors for classroom wear: navy, khaki, or white.

Uniform Availability:

Uniforms are available through Parker School Uniforms at 1125 Oakland Blvd., Fort Worth, 817/429-9969. **If you can find less expensive uniforms elsewhere, you may purchase them, but they must be identical to our uniforms sold at Parker School Uniform. (We have samples of uniforms at the school).** *Other non-uniform styles with logos are not acceptable.*

Friday free dress:

Students who *earn* this privilege may wear non-uniform clothes that meet the general school dress code (**no mini skirts, short-shorts, tight leather pants, spaghetti strap tops or dresses, tank tops, or tight fitting jeans, pants, or tops**). Hip hugger jeans and short shirts that show a student's midriff are not allowed. See the Student Handbook. STUDENTS SHOULD DRESS MODESTLY.

NOTE: Students who come to school not meeting the dress code will receive Disciplinary marks, and **parents will be called to school to bring the proper clothes.**
